Minutes of Meeting

• The meeting was chaired by Dr. Asha Boaz

- Dr. Asha Boaz, the Chairperson, welcomed the gathering and shared the Mission, Vision, and Value statements of the school.
- The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Dr. Asha Boaz. Ms Manju proposed to approval of the minutes, which was seconded by Ms. Jasinth.
- Ms. Manju Sukumaran, the Principal emphasized the significance of procuring the APAAR ID.
- She outlined the various Career Guidance Programmes offered to students of Classes 9 to 12 during the AY 2024-25.
- Ms. Manju highlighted the Boaz Remedial sessions and shared that parents highly appreciated the school's efforts in assisting students struggling with academic concepts.
- She proudly announced that Sai Anish of Class 10 secured a Gold Medal in the National Automobile Olympiad Examination held in Bhopal.
- She briefed the members on several initiatives, including the Innovation Park Visit, Immersia 2025 at MCC, and the school's collaboration with IIT-M.
- She also lauded that active participation of students in the Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan, the largest digital-based science talent examination, and GESMUN the Model United Nations held at Good Earth School.
- The Principal informed the SMC Members about the revision in tuition fees, citing enhanced campus security measures, increased cost of maintenance and utilities, the upgrading of learning resources, and the retention of highly qualified teachers.
- Ms. Annammal, MS VP shared the Annual Theme My India, Secular India and explained that all activities planned for the academic year 2024-25 align with this theme.
- She provided details on various school events, including KG Fancy Dress Competition, Scouts & Guides Camp, Boaz Pillow Party – for students of Classes 6 & 7, Boaz Kabaddi – an Interschool Event, Sports Day, Kaleidoscope, Club Day, Founder's Day, Pongal Celebration, Tamil Sangamam, and Quiz Quest.
- She took pride in sharing that Yokesh, Prajeesh, and Karthika brought laurels to the school by winning medals in the CBSE Cluster Tournaments. She also shared that
